Dr. Pirumyan earned his medical degree from St. Petersburg State Medical University and Yerevan State Medical University. He completed a residency in pathological anatomy and forensic medicine at the National Institute of Health of the Republic of Armenia.

Dr. Pirumyan then studied epidemiology and earned his master of public health degree from UCLA. He subsequently completed a second residency at The University of Oklahoma, Health Sciences Center studying anatomic and clinical pathology. While there, he was co-chief resident and was recognized with the Parker-Heartland award for outstanding performance in anatomic pathology.

He then pursued a fellowship in hematopathology from Tulane University Health Sciences Center, where he was an active member of the Joint Tulane Medical Center and Tulane Health Sciences Center Clinical Laboratory Quality Improvement Cluster Committee.

Dr. Pirumyan began working as a hematopathologist and staff pathologist, where he acted as medical director of transfusion medicine for Hillcrest Medical Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma. While there, he stood on the hospital's Clinical Quality Improvement Council.

He then accepted a position at Integris

Baptist Medical Center in Oklahoma City, and took on the additional duties of Laboratory Medical Director at three additional facilities. He was also a member of the hospital's Pharmacy and Therapeutics Quality Improvement subcommittee.
